

**Restore Coop Apportionment to Original Formula: 50/50
(Average Daily Membership/Equalized Valuation)
Petition Warrant Article
2020 Hollis Brookline Coop School District Meeting**

This petition warrant article proposes that the apportionment of all costs (capital and operating) for the Hollis/Brookline Cooperative School District be restored to its original formula used when the district was formed on July 1, 1991: 50% on average daily membership and 50% on equalized property valuation. This formula was the original compromise and reflects the most prevalent apportionment formula used in cooperative school districts within New Hampshire.

To see if the Hollis Brookline Cooperative School District will vote to amend the Articles of Agreement of the Hollis Brookline Cooperative School District by deleting Article 5 as it is currently written and substituting a new Article 5 as follows:

**The capital and operating expenses of the Hollis/Brookline Cooperative School District, payable in each fiscal year, shall be apportioned fifty percent (50%) on the average daily membership (ADM) of the students in grades 7 through 12 from each pre-existing district of the Cooperative School District during the preceding fiscal year, as determined by the State Department of Education, and fifty percent (50%) on the most recent equalized valuation of the pre-existing districts, as determined by the Department of Revenue Administration.
